## Overview

Vision Carthage is seeking a talented artist to bring our vision for a colorful floral mural to a space strategically located near the site of the new Kolpin Farmer's Market Pavilion. The mural will incorporate vivid colors and bold floral designs to celebrate "Carthage in Bloom," weaving our beautification initiative into an area where we anticipate good things growing for many years to come.

## Specifications

1. The mural should be designed with the elements in mind. Long-lasting paint and sealant fit for outdoor exposure in all weather conditions is a must.
2. Bid should include estimated cost for any equipment needed, including lift, scaffolding, paint, primer, sealants, drop cloth, etc.
3. Bid should include cost for design time, wall prep, and details on how long the mural is guaranteed and if touch-ups are included.
4. The mural should cover the entire gray brick area.

## Design

The Vision Carthage Mural Committee has a design theme in mind for this area. We're simply searching for an artist to bring this vision to life. While there is room for artist input and some slight changes to this design, the final product should result in a work that keeps the integrity of the desire by the committee. In addition to colorful botanicals, the mural should incorporate the phrase, "Carthage in Bloom."
